

HORSEBACK RIDING

Head off on your great island adventure on horseback and let the world slip away as the fluid movement of the horse transports you back to the time when life was simpler and unhurried, like it still is on St. Maarten. For horseback riding along the coast, you will be transported by bus to the riding stables. Enjoy a guided trail ride followed by a "dip" in the water with the horses before making your way back to the stables.

You can enjoy 45 minutes of snorkeling and a fresh soft drink at the end of your escapade. Our guide's boat is always equipped with fresh drinks, safety and snorkel gear for your convenience. Bags will be provided to store personal belongings in your little compartment under your seat. Wear your swimsuit, watershoes, bring a towel and sunscreen and waterproof camera if you would like to take some underwater pictures.

ATV TOUR

Experience the island on fancy quads. Starting point is the Westin St. Maarten Dawn Beach Resort and Spa; there, guests are briefed on how the equipment works. They are then taken on main road to Orient Beach. Guests next head to the capital of the Dutch side, Philipsburg, and down Front Street where there are over 50 stores to chose from by some of the biggest names. KAYAKING (Simpsonbay Lagoon Tour)

Continue on along the coast where you will be shown the invisible border which has signified a peaceful separation of the Dutch and French parts of St. Maarten since the 1600's. Paddling past some of the world's most luxurious motor yachts you will continue out through the Bridge into the quiet bay for a well deserved swim at the beautiful Simpsonbay Beach. Finish up at Port de Plaisance Resort with a cold refreshment and good conversation with your guides.

ISLAND TOUR & SHOPPING IN PHILIPSBURG

Continuous upgrading of Philipsburg, the capitol of the Dutch side, is a jewel town built along the shores of Great Bay. The sparkling turquoise waters of the Caribbean Sea are never more than a few steps away when you are in picturesque Philipsburg. The sweeping Great Bay beach promenade stretches the length of the beach and is dotted with restaurants, bars, colorful beach chairs, and parasols. This cool and breezy island location is always buzzing with activity in the day and is a hot spot in the evening. Wander along cobbled Front Street where you'll find wonderful shopping for electronics, jewelry, designer clothing, perfumes and much more. Pop into the stores that have offered discount vouchers or free gifts. Stroll along the new Boardwalk that stretches the length of the beach of Great Bay. Other attractions in Philipsburg are the St. Maarten Museum that offers a glimpse into the island's history, casinos, the historic courthouse, and Cyrus Wathey Square flanked by elegant royal palm trees. The square opens up to Captain Hodge Wharf where ship tenders pick up and drop off cruise passengers. The wharf is an excellent place to take in majestic Great Bay, a natural deep water harbor.

This awesome experience, gives you an unimaginable thrill as you glide on very secure zip lines strung through some of the tallest Royal Palm trees on the island. We guarantee it will be one of the most exciting rides of your life! From the resort, you will be transferred to Loterie Farms by bus. Once at the destination, you will be met by the friendly "cable guys" who will instruct you traveling along this exhilarating course. "Get Harnessed and Get High" and enjoy the best Eco-Trip there is. Then it's up, up and away! The exhilarating adventure course consists of a sequence of zip-lines, rope swings and 'bridges' suspended from platforms mounted in the trees of the forest that will leave you in a physical and mental state of total euphoria.
